Jesus Keeps the Father's Promise

Each family member should take a blank sheet of paper or a blank sticky note and pray about the following: What is one promise you can make to God this week that you will try and keep? After each family member writes down their promise, they should share with each other and post these promises in a central place in the house. Each night this week, family members should take time sharing how they are doing in terms of keeping that promise.
